

MANUSCRIPT PREPARATION GUIDELINES

All papers must be written and presented in English.

- Authors must submit final manuscript in A4 (210 x 297 mm) or local equivalent size: (text area is 160 mm x 247 mm), as an electronic copy in pdf format.
- The electronic copy should be an attachment to an email message.
- To be included in the Proceedings papers **MUST** reach the ISSF2006 Organizing Committee before 15th October 2006.
- Submission is interpreted as a statement that the author(s) have obtained all the necessary permissions and will present the paper at the ISSF.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PREPARING THE MANUSCRIPT

Times-Roman font is used throughout.

The bulk of the text should be 12-point with single line spacing throughout.

First line of text on ALL pages including the first should begin 25 mm from the top and have a text length of 240 mm and a width of 160 mm.

The length of the paper should not exceed 6 pages, including text, figures, tables and references.

TITLE OF THE PAPER

Title of paper is centered, first letter of word in title upper case, bold, 14-point single spacing and should not exceed 2 lines.

Leave 1 lines space.

AUTHOR(S)

First and surname of author(s) are centered in 12-point font, single line spacing – leave 1 line space. Please underline the name of the presenting author.

AFFILIATION

Authors(s) contact details, and email address are in 11 point font, centered in single space – leave 1 line space.

ABSTRACT (Flush left, bold, Lower Case, 12-point -)

The abstract should include basic information. It should be no more than 12 lines long in 12-point Times-Roman font. (Leave 1 line space)

PRIMARY HEADINGS

Number primary headings: e.g.

1. Introduction (indent text to 8 mm)

Flush left, Title Case, 12-point Times-Roman – bold text.

Leave 1 line space between paragraphs - do not indent. Avoid footnotes if possible.

SECONDARY HEADINGS

Secondary number heading: e.g.

1.1 Sub-Heading (indent text to 8 mm)

Flush left, Title Case, 11-point Times-Roman – bold text.

FIGURES AND TABLES

All figures and tables are to be inserted into the text. Captions are to be typed in 11 point font.

Photographs will only be accepted if they are already scanned and included in the .pdf document.

Tables and figures should be numbered consecutively.

Captions of tables should be placed above and centered.

Captions of figures should be placed below and centered.

Leave 1 line space below figures and tables.

Formulas and equations should be numbered consecutively with numbers flush right in brackets (3).

References in text should be cited as:

research by Smith and Jones (2006)

example: linear theory (Smith, 2006; Jones, 2006)

example: linear theory (Smith and Jones, 2006)

example: linear theory (Smith et al., 2006).

REFERENCES

References should appear in alphabetic order at the end of the paper. Indent second line of reference by 10 mm.

Smith, J. (2006) title of paper. *J. Fluid Mech.*, 000:00-00.

Smith, J., Jones, A.B. and Bills, J.C. References should appear in alphabetic order at the end of the paper. *J. Fluid Mech.*, 000:00-00.
